Wind in the Roundhouse Concert:

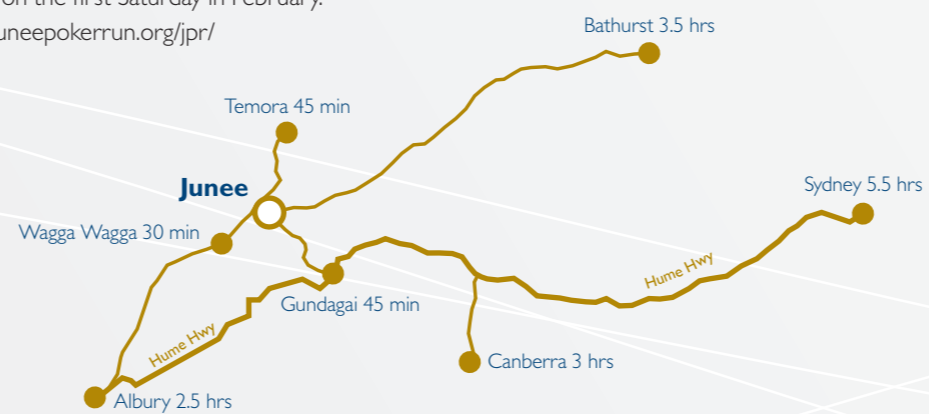
Junee's *Wind in the Roundhouse* concert, organised by Junee Shire Arts Council, is held every March in the famous Railway Roundhouse.

Poker Run: This annual event raises money to assist local cancer patients and is held on the first Saturday in February. www.juneepokerrun.org/jpr/

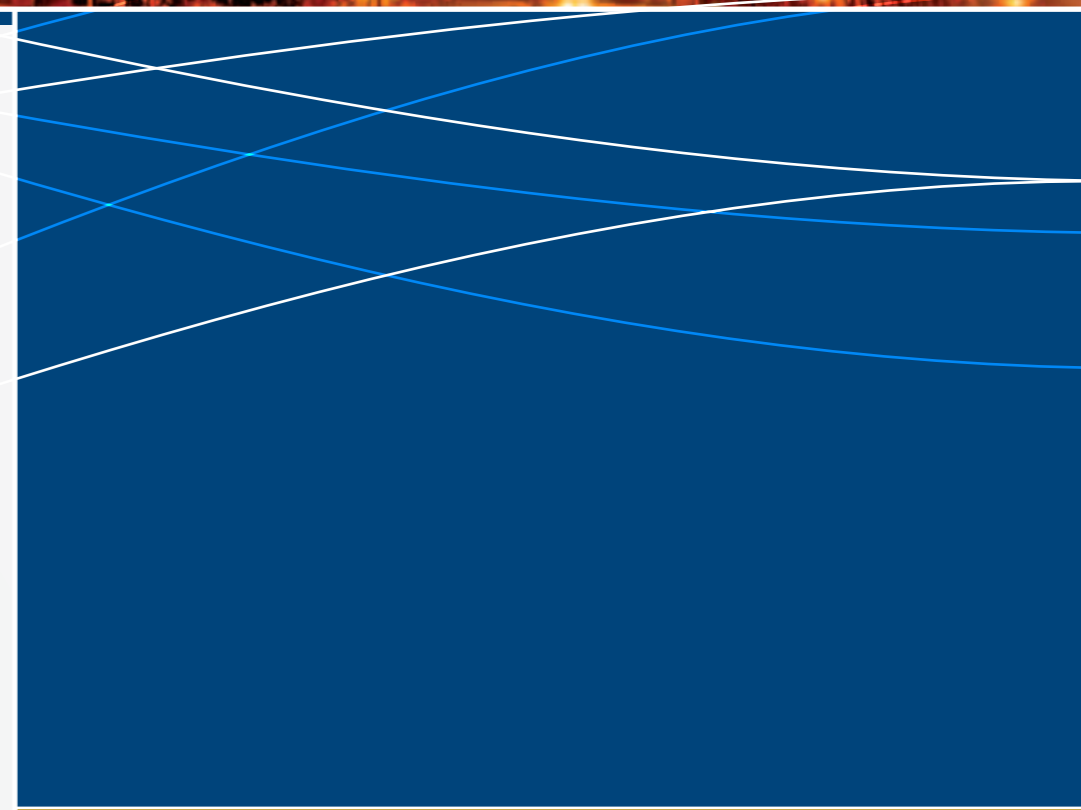
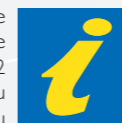
Heritage Tours

Pastoralists first took up holdings around the Junee area in 1845, but it was not until the railway arrived later in the century that the town developed. By the end of 1886 Junee was booming with six hotels and twelve stores among its assortment of buildings.

Railway Square

This elegant square was designed and built in French Renaissance style in 1881. With its sweeping platform and beautiful cast iron verandahs, Junee's Railway Square brings back to life the time when people walked to the shops, strolled on Sundays and journeyed by steam train.

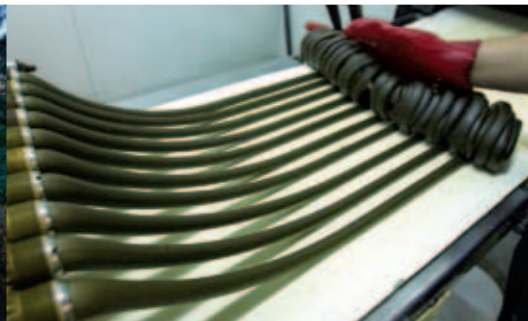
Junee Roundhouse – Rail & Transport Museum

In a workshop built to maintain trains everything is BIG. The Junee Roundhouse was once the largest railway roundhouse in the southern hemisphere. Not only has it survived, it is still a fully operational repair and maintenance service station for engines and rolling stock.
